Remarks:	Leaves entire, shining, lanceolate. Flowers solitary, sometimes 2-4 together on terminating short shoots. Calyx tubular, scarlet, with 5-7 triangular fleshy lobes. Petals scarlet, wrinkled. Fruit globular, crowned with calyx, and with a thick fleshy rind. Seeds red, fleshy, juicy.		
Local Uses:	Fruit edible. Seeds are dried, sold in market as amandari and used as condiment.
