IIT Mandi to observe its 5th Convocation Ceremony on October 7th

The Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Mandi will observe its Fifth Convocation Ceremony on the 7th of October 2017. The Chief Guest for the occasion will be **Shri. Banmali Agrawala**, President, Infrastructure, Defence and Aerospace of TATA Sons. **Shri. Subodh Bhargava**, Chairman, TATA Communications Limited and also the Chairperson of the Board of Governors of IIT Mandi will also grace the function with his presence. This year IIT Mandi will graduate 24 Ph.D. students, 7 M.S. (by Research) students, 18 M.Sc. students, 4 M. Tech. and 116 B. Tech. students in the current Convocation.

Established in 2009, IIT Mandi has the unique distinction of being the first IIT located in the Himalayan region. In a short span of 8 years, the Institute has grown to prominence at national and international levels through the achievements made by its students and faculty. The campus presently accommodates almost 1000 students and 100 faculty members. The student strength is constituted of 544 B. Tech., 34 MS (by Research), 86 M. Tech., 94 M.Sc, 17 integrated M.Sc.-Ph.D. (Physics), and 239 students in Ph. D. programmes across various disciplines. All students presently reside in the permanent campus of the Institute in Kamand and Salgi, situated on the banks of river Uhl.
