Report

A national workshop on "Bioprocessing for Energy and Carbon from Agro Residues (BECAR-2018)" was organized by the School of Basic Sciences IIT Mandi from 23rd-24th January. The workshop is supported by IIT Mandi and DBT-BMBF (Indo-German) project that is active at IIT Mandi and Karlsruhe Institute of Technology Germany. About 60 faculties, students and scientists participated in the workshop representing 10 academic and research organizations.



The workshop was aimed at various processes for the conversion of polymeric Biowaste into profitable products with an emphasis on microbial bioprocessing and pyrolysis process. The workshop facilitated discussions by young scientists and students on a broad range of topics including waste-pretreatment, microbial bioprocessing, associated analytical methods, bioreactor design, pyrolysis, and characterization and applications of pyrolytic carbon.
